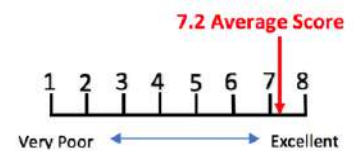

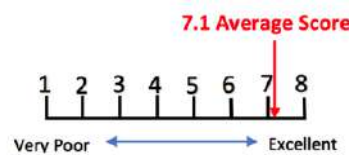
Each delegate was asked to rate a series of questions regarding the course, where 1 was "Very Poor" and 8 was "Excellent".

100% of delegates would recommend this course

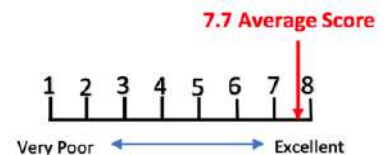
Achievement of stated objectives



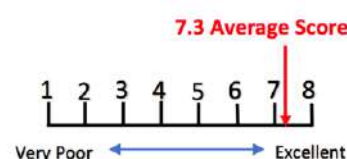
Value of training in relation to job
